The event was structured in two parts:

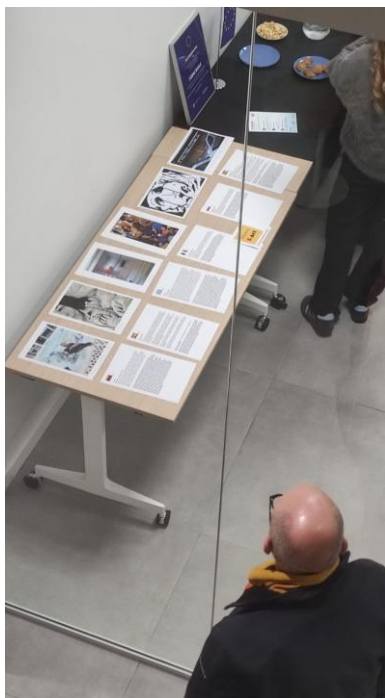
1. Presentation of the Move&Act Project

 - Discussion on the importance of visual storytelling as a tool for youth expression and advocacy.

Promotion of the event:

The event was promoted through a targeted social media campaign and email invitations to relevant stakeholders.
